We're in Costa Rica!

March 11 was a very exciting day! We arrived in Costa Rica that afternoon. We have settled into and are staying in our Area Director's house until the end of the year. Thank you Jay and Nancy Dickerson for the blessing of staying in your home while you are itinerating.

We arrived just in time to attend the annual General Assembly of the Assemblies of God in Costa Rica. During the three day event, we reconnected with old friends, and met many new friends, too.

Natalie and Niki began school soon after our arrival. They are so happy that homeschooling is over, and excited about going to school and making new friends.

April has been a time of connecting with church leaders. We have visited and ministered in several churches and regional meetings. We have also met with national leaders, presbyters and pastors. It is exciting to see and hear what God is doing through the Assemblies of God in Costa Rica and we consider it a privilege to be a part of it.

In the upcoming months, we will be visiting the regional Bible Schools in San Carlos and Liberia. We will also be visiting church plant sites in the provinces of Alajuela and Heredia. Also, Miguel has been invited to visit and minister at the Cabécar Indigenous Reserves in Talamanca and Chirripó. Maria will be teaching English to a South American missionary family.

We entered Costa Rica with a 90-day visa. This visa is renewable upon leaving the country for a period of 72 hours. We decided it would be best to immediately gather the required documents for residency. It is a difficult process, but it is not impossible. Please pray that the Lord would give us favor throughout this process.
